### HOUSE OF EUROPE IN RHODES

<p><b>Experience of similar actions, in relation to role in the implementation of the proposed action</b></p>	<p>The House of Europe in Rhodes was funded in 1999 with the purpose of spreading the European ideals and the communication among the peoples of Europe, in order to facilitate the European integration and to create a network of dialogue towards the goal inside Europe and with the rest of the Mediterranean. In this respect, the House of Europe in Rhodes, organized International and National Conferences on European issues. Educational and cultural projects and activities for adults and youths.</p> <p>The House of Europe in Rhodes in collaboration with the IUC of Denmark, organized its 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference in Rhodes, 24 - 29 September 2007, titled «Waves of Democracy», simultaneously organized in Brandbjerg, Denmark. Fifty youths, 18 – 30 years of age, from 18 European countries, divided in 5 Committees have collaborated, discussed, proposed solutions, voted and prepared the «Citizen’s Agenda» which together with the results of this North-South Dialogue, was presented at the European Parliament in Brussels, in October 2007.</p> <p>Except of its participation as an associate in the Mare Nostrum European Program it has realized a Euroscola European Program, organizing a written competition in order to select 25 youths to participate together with another 300 in a Youth Conference in Strasbourg.</p> <p>Today it participates as a partner in another 2 European programs: Grundtvig-Reperes and Youth in Action.</p>
<p><b>Role and involvement in preparing the proposed action</b></p>	<p>Made available information on the Old City of Rhodes (“<i>Palià Poli</i>”) and the initiatives in communication within European people. Helped in preparing the Concept Note and the final proposal in regard to the organization of events.</p>
<p><b>Role and involvement in implementing the proposed action</b></p>	<p>The House of Europe-Rhodes is one of the six Associates of MARE NOSTRUM. Due to its experience in collecting data, related to communication, organization of events, it aimed at facilitating European integration, valorization of intangible heritage and creation of a network of dialogue within the Mediterranean basin, they will participate in the Field survey on the Mediterranean port-cities along the Phoenician routes in cooperation with Paralleli, Medieval City of Rhodes and City of Tyre (WP2) and in designing the awareness-raising campaign: plan the what, how and when issues, in cooperation with USJ/MAJAL, City of Tyre, SAMOTRACIA, DELARPA, IHM, and UGARIT (WP3). In addition they will participate to the Data collection, to the networking with the relevant stakeholders, to the preparation of the Handicraft show exhibition, to the training activities and to the organization of the international competitions among youths and students, with final dissemination of results from MARE</p>
