<p><b>Experience of similar actions, in relation to the role in the implementation of the proposed action</b></p>	<p>Various cooperation projects has been going on in the last years, like: KATHARSOPOLIS-EEU:B7 6200/99/0275/DEV/ENV for Technical assistance, Sensitization in environmental issues, and Sustainable Development through empowerment of tourism, handicrafts and cultural heritage promotion,</p> <p>MERCATOR "Routes des Marchands, Villes des Marchées, en Méditerranée" (Programme INTERREG III B MEDOCC pour la cohésion des territoires de Europe du Sud),</p> <p>The most important project, started some years ago, and still ongoing, is the CHUD/Cultural Heritage and Urban Development Project (funded by the World Bank, AFD/"Agence Française de Développement" and the Italian Government). This project almost completed its first phase of urban rehabilitation (infrastructure, waterfront and restoration of some historical buildings) and is entering in the second phase of preservation, rehabilitation and improvement of existing archaeological sites.</p>
<p><b>Role and involvement in preparing the proposed action</b></p>	<p>Making available information on the city: its urban characteristics, its problems and its expectations, as well as on others ongoing projects like the CHUD- Cultural Heritage &amp; Urban Development which targets the archaeological sites of Tyre (Al-Bass and Tyr-La-Cité) and historic parts of the city.</p> <p>Sharing data to shape a future involvement of the City in the project</p> <p>Tyre can be an interesting example for MARE NOSTRUM, as a city rich in archaeological heritage still not properly managed and exploited, and where to rebuild its old, important connection with the sea, and promote and empower its old traditional handicrafts.</p>
<p><b>Role and involvement in implementing the proposed action</b></p>	<p>The city of Tyre is one of the four Partners of MARE NOSTRUM, and have a good experience in Cultural Heritage Management, acquired through different cooperation project and especially through the implementation of the ongoing CHUD (Cultural Heritage and Urban Development) Project, to which MARE NOSTRUM intend to link.
